

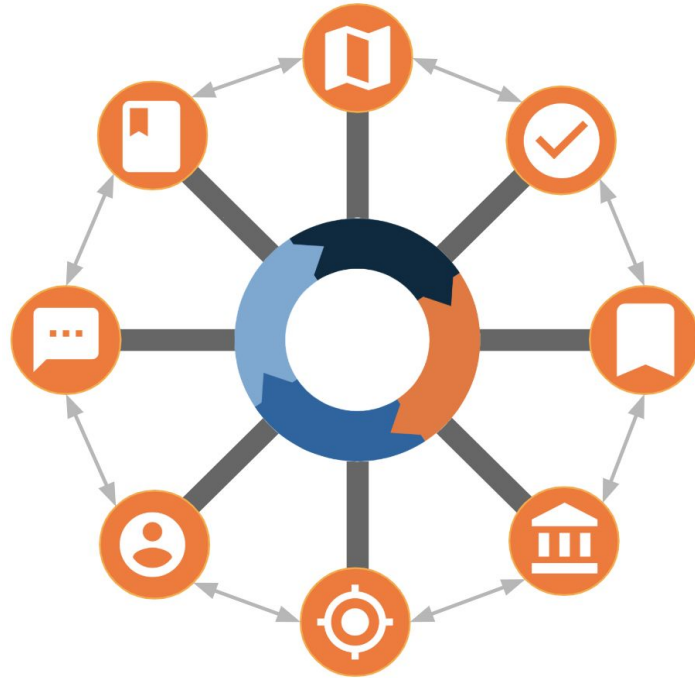

Curriculum Mapping + Outcomes Alignment Solution

Key Benefits

- Manage curriculum mapping and outcomes alignment for all academic and non-academic programs
- Create relationships among institutional, college, accreditor, program learning outcomes, and course learning outcomes
- Use courses, co-curricular experiences and digital credentials throughout the mapping process
- Visually design developmentally appropriate programs
- Define proficiency scales for easy outcome reporting at any level
- Revise programs and curriculum maps through versioning
- Configure each program based on particular needs

Success Examples

- **University of Rochester** managing professionally accredited program mappings for internal and external reporting (2018)
- **Messiah College** mapping and aligning all program and general education curricula (2019)
- **University of the Sciences Philadelphia College of Pharmacy** implementing new competency-driven curriculum including co-curricular experiences linked to competencies and ACPE Standards (2017)

Outcomes Assessment + Evidence Collection Solution

Key Benefits

- Collect outcomes assessment data and evidence using multiple methods and sources
- Reduce instructor workload through automation of assessment data collection
- Identify existing assignments from courses or co-curricular experiences as evidence
- Create assignments in AEFIS or link LMS assignments to outcomes based on curriculum map
- Automate copying of assignments and assignment linking from previous terms
- Assess course learning outcomes without the requirement for a curriculum map
- Manage centralized library of assignment rubrics
- Enable multiple assessors and score assignments using rubrics on any device in real-time
- Support random sampling and external assessors
- Conduct inter-rater reliability testing and studies

- **Texas A&M University** assessing general education outcomes through random sampling and inter-rater reliability. (2019)
- **University of Wisconsin, Madison** assessing course learning outcomes without curriculum maps (2019)
- **Messiah College** collecting 99% of general education assessment and 88% of academic program assessment. (2019)
- **School of the Art Institute of Chicago** assessing capstone student portfolios (2020)

Key Benefits

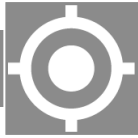
- Empower learners with validated evidence of their achievements using Comprehensive Learner Record (CLR)
- Create visibility into learning across the institution including curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular experiences
- Provide learners real-time feedback to create agency, inform growth and achievement in terms of outcomes and skills
- Enable learners to take their achievements with them and digitally share portfolio with all stakeholders including employers
- Identify learners who are at risk using deeper insight into their learning and outcomes achievement
- Support learners with advising aligned to outcomes and skills as opposed to mere course grades
- Align with industry standards from IMS Global, NASPA and AACRAO including principles of self-sovereign identity and FERPA

- **University of Rochester** implementing CLR for 1-Year Clinical Laboratory Program (2019)
- **University of the Sciences Philadelphia** College of Pharmacy implementing CLR and empowering students with evidence of their learning (2018)

Strategic Planning + Data Collection Solution

Key Benefits

- Manage and track university-wide, college and department strategic plans
- Gather evidence to support strategic objectives including key-performance indicators (KPIs)
- Display dashboards of goal performance in real-time
- Create and automate program/unit assessment, promotion & tenure, curriculum & course review and more through workflows
- Create an approval process for course and program creation/substantive changes

- **University of Wisconsin, Madison** collecting annual assessment reports (2018)
- **Texas A&M University** automating university program/unit assessments with two feedback loops (2019)
- **Messiah College** creating workflow for programs to track assessment plan and reports annually (2019)
- **Waubensee Community College** automating their career & technical and degree reports for the state of Illinois (2019)

Course + Syllabus Management Solution

Key Benefits

- Manage course catalog and co-curricular experiences
- Create syllabi templates and central repository of policies that are hierarchically organized
- Seamless LMS integration for instructors and students
- Develop a single-source of truth for course learning outcomes
- Display related institutional, college, accreditor and program learning outcomes
- Automate copying of syllabus content from previous terms
- Archive previous term syllabi
- Revise courses and co-curricular experiences through versioning
- Export syllabi to accreditor specific formats
- Comply with ADA/WCAG 2.1

Course Evaluation + Feedback Solution

Key Benefits

- Automate evaluation and feedback campus-wide
- Conduct formative and summative evaluations
- Schedule beginning, middle and end of term course evaluations university-wide based on academic calendar
- Deploy surveys to students, instructors, alumni, and other stakeholders
- Complete surveys on any device including mobile
- Create dynamic questions based on Course Learning Outcomes from student and instructor perspectives
- Create dynamic questions based on specific instructors
- Build hierarchical survey templates with the ability for instructors to add questions
- Automate notifications to students and instructors
- Create a question library that is organized hierarchically
- Integrate evaluations seamlessly with the LMS

- **Lincoln Land Community College** Self Efficacy Pre/Post survey on HIPs (2020)

Faculty Activity + Curriculum Vitae Solution

Key Benefits

- Create a central repository for instructor intellectual contributions, service, professional organizations and credentials
- Build library of intellectual work that include scholarly journals and books
- Automate notifications for instructors to update portfolio annually
- Export portfolio based on NSF, and accrediting-body standards
- Manage the entire promotion and tenure lifecycle with workflows and dynamic forms

- **University of Houston, Victoria** automated collection of faculty portfolio's for AACSB Accreditation (2016)
- **Texas A&M International University** campus-wide portfolio repository for SACSCOC and AACSB Accreditations (2019)

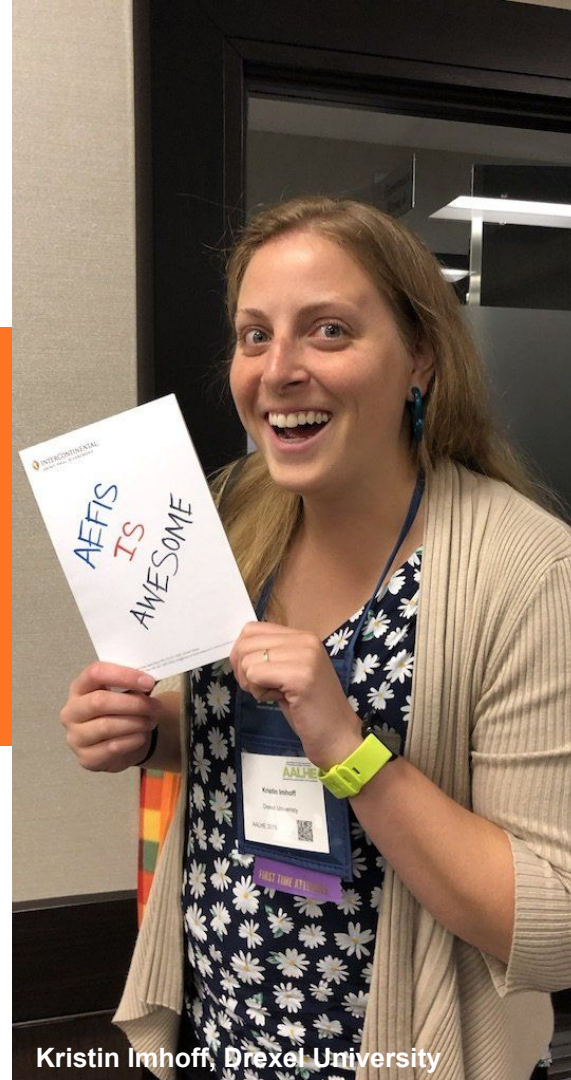
